- To assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely Datta Meghe Ayurvedic Medical College, Hospital & Research Center, YCCE Campus, Wanadongri, Hingna Road, Nagpur-441110, Maharashtra (AYU0534) inspection was conducted on 02.05.2025 and 03.05.2025 on Hybrid mode by the visitation team of Medical Asessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process the issuance of Lettter of Intent (LoI) to start 12 new PG courses with 77 seats in the subject namely (1)Agad Tantra avum Vidhi Vaidyaka- 07 seats (2) Rasa shastra & Bhaisajya Kalpana-07 seats (3) Dravyguna Vigyana-07 seats (4) Kaumarbhritya-06 seats (5) Kayachikitsa-05 seats (6) Panchakarma-06 seats (7) Prasuti & Stri Roga-06 seats (8) Ayurveda Samhita & Siddanta-07 seats (9) Rog Nidana avum Vikriti Vigyan-07 seats (10) Shalya Tantra-06 seats (11) Shalakya Tantra-06 seats (12) Swasthvritta-07 seats under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 from the academic session 2025-26.
- 2. The visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulations namely the Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals Regulations, 2024", MESAR PG Ayurveda 2024, provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations thereunder and defects/ shortcoming were found in the assessment and was informed to you vide letter of even no. dated 23.07.2025. In response of the same, you have submitted the clarification vide letter dated 24.07.2025.
- 3. The assessment report along with the submitted clarification was duly placed in the 137th Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) convened on 30.07.2025 and Board observed that the college is fulfilling the notified & requisite approved criteria for issuance of permission as per the concerned Acts and regulations. Hence, the Board decided to issue LoI (Letter of Intent) in accordance with Regulation 42 (1)((a) (ii) of MESAR PG Ayurveda 2024 to start 12 PG courses with 77 seats in the subject namely (1) Agad Tantra avum vidhi vaidyaka- 07 seats (2) Rasa shastra & Bhaisajya Kalpana-07 seats (3) Dravyguna Vigyana-07 seats (4) Kaumarbhritya-06 seats (5) Kayachikitsa-05 seats (6) Panchakarma-06 seats (7) Prasuti & Stri Roga-06 seats (8) Ayurveda Samhita & Siddanta-07 seats (9) Rog Nidana avum Vikriti Vigyan-07 seats (10) Shalya Tantra-06 seats (11) Shalakya Tantra -06 seats (12) Swasthvritta-07 seats under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 from the academic session 2025-26.

4. Therefore, Datta Meghe Ayurvedic Medical College, Hospital & Research Center, YCCE Campus, Wanadongri, Hingna Road, Nagpur-441110, Maharashtra (AYU0534) is hereby granted with LoI (Letter of Intent) in accordance with Regulation 42 (1)((a) (ii) of MESAR PG Ayurveda 2024 to start 12 PG courses with 77 seats in the subject (1) Agad Tantra avum vidhi vaidyaka- 07 seats (2) Rasa shastra & Bhaisajya Kalpana-07 seats (3) Dravyguna Vigyana-07 seats (4) Kaumarbhritya-06 seats (5) Kayachikitsa-05 seats (6) Panchakarma-06 seats (7) Prasuti & Stri Roga-06 seats (8) Ayurveda Samhita & Siddanta-07 seats (9) Rog Nidana avum Vikriti Vigyan-07 seats (10) Shalya Tantra-06 seats (11) Shalakya Tantra -06 seats (12) Swasthvritta-07 seats under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 from

the academic session 2025-26, and relevant regulations there under, subject to the condition that following conditions shall be fulfilled before issuance of Letter of permission (LOP) for the academic session 2025-26, failing which the Letter of Permission (LOP) shall not be issued and Letter of Intent (LOI) issued shall be deemed to be withdrawn.

- All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled,
- ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024,
- iii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Post Graduate Education in Ayurveda) Regulations, 2024,
- iv) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.
- v) Achieving a grade of "A" or "B" in the forthcoming QCI inspection for the academic year 2025-26 as per the undertaking submitted vide ref no. **DMAMCHRC/2024-25/737 dated 16.01.2025**.
- The remaining application and processing fees along with GST as specified in Table 11 of MESAR PG 2024 before issuance of LOP.
- 5. The applicant is also need to submit the requisite fixed security deposit as specified under the section 43 (2) (a) of notified Regulations namely the "Minimum essential standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Post Graduate Education in Ayurveda) Regulations, 2024" on demand before issuance of Letter of Permission (LOP).
- 6. The college administration is to ensure that no student is admitted in the PG course till the formal permission i.e. Letter of Permission (LOP) is granted.
- 7. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) shall visit the college virtually, physically or on Hybrid mode to verify the compliance/ fulfillment of the above conditions by the applicant and issuing/not issuing the LOP shall be considered.
- In the event, the applicant college fails to comply with or satisfy the conditions of the Letter of Intent; the Letter of Intent shall be deemed to have been withdrawn without further intimation to the applicant.
